## Robert and Carroll Heideman Award Application Materials

**Application Deadline: February 2, 2009, 4:00 p.m.**

### **Eligibility Requirements**

All full-time (12 credits or more) students currently enrolled at UW-Madison at the time of application are considered eligible to apply, including undergraduate, graduate and professional students. All students must be available for in-person interviews in Madison during the spring 2009 semester.

This award seeks to recognize students who demonstrate the following:

1. A commitment to community involvement through a demonstrated role in civic engagement, public service and volunteerism.
2. A drive toward future leadership.
3. A proven commitment to advocacy on behalf of the UW and its students, as well as a strong belief in the power of education.

In addition, a demonstration of financial need will be considered in awarding these scholarships.

### **Awards Review Process**

Completed application materials must be submitted in their entirety by the specified deadline. Applications are distributed to a screening committee for a first round of review. Following the initial review and ranking process, applicants with the highest scores will be invited to interview with our alumni interview committee during the spring semester. The interview committee will determine the final award recipients. Recipients will be recognized during the WAA Alumni Weekend program, which will take place in May 2009. Attending this program is a requirement for eligibility for this award.

### **Application Materials**

The following documents must be received at WAA no later than **4:00 p.m. on Feb. 2, 2009**:

- One completed Personal Data Form.
- Ten legible photocopies of the completed Student Award Application, collated and stapled with student ID listed on each page; do not include your name on this document.
- One campus/unofficial copy of your transcript (may be printed via "My UW.")
