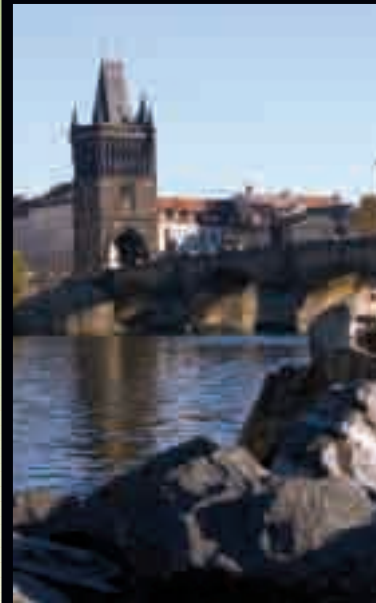

DAY ONE

DAY TWO

Upon arrival, transfer by motorcoach to **Cesky Krumlov** and the First-Class **Hotel Ruze**. (Transfer provided for Air Program participants only.)

DAY THREE

Educational Focus: Bohemia History.

Excursion: Orientation of Cesky Krumlov. Enjoy a morning tour of this unique, historic town. See its impressive castle complex and the stunning Baroque theater. Admire the town center, with its dazzling array of medieval, Renaissance and Baroque architecture.

DAY FOUR

Excursion: Holasovice.

Today's journey begins with a visit to the charming village of Holasovice, known for its 18th- and 19th-century buildings built in the South Bohemian Folk Baroque style.

Excursion: Jindrichuv Hradec.

This afternoon, visit the 13th-century Jindrichuv Hradec, one of the largest castle complexes in the Czech Republic. Admire its extensive assortment of well-preserved Renaissance furnishings.

Educational Focus: Meet the People.

PLZEN

DAY FIVE

Depart Cesky Krumlov for **Plzen**. Upon arrival, check into the **Marriot Courtyard Plzen**.

Excursion: Hluboka Chateau. Stop to see the Hluboka Chateau, a romantic and extravagant Tudor-style castle. This castle was the seat of the Schwarzenberg dynasty and its beautiful interior boasts rich collections of period furniture.

Local Flavor: Enjoy a delicious lunch en route to Plzen.

Excursion: Plzen City Tour. See the many delights of this enchanting city, including the Church of St. Bartholomew

and the Great Synagogue, the third largest in the world. Visit the birthplace of pale lager, Pilsner Urquell brewery, and enjoy a tour and tasting.

Educational Focus: The Velvet Revolution.

DAY SIX

Excursion: Prague. Travel to the magnificent city of Prague. See the spectacular Charles Bridge and visit Prague Castle. See its 10th-century structures and St. Vitus Cathedral, the spiritual heart of the Czech Republic. Conclude at the Jewish Quarter, known for the oldest synagogue in Europe. Enjoy some free time to explore the Old Town Square on your own.

DAY SEVEN

Educational Focus: Contemporary Czech Republic and the E.U.

Excursion: Moser Glass and Karlovy Vary. Visit Moser Glass Factory and its museum, which features the development of Czech glass-making and learn about this ancient art. Then continue to Karlovy Vary, the oldest and largest of Bohemia's spa towns, famous for being frequented by members of royalty such as Czar Peter the Great and Emperor Franz Josef. See the splendid spa buildings, walk along the impressive Mill Colonnade and visit the Russian Orthodox Church, known for its five golden onion domes.

DAY EIGHT

Independent Exploration: The day is at leisure to pursue independent interests. You may wish to take the complimentary shuttle to Prague to continue your exploration of this spectacular city.

Tonight, gather with fellow travelers for a *Farewell Reception and Graduation Ceremony* followed by dinner at the hotel.

MOBILITY AND FITNESS TO TRAVEL-The right is retained to decline to accept or to retain any person as a member of this trip who, in the opinion of AHI Travel is unfit for travel or whose physical or mental condition may constitute a danger to themselves or to others on the trip, subject only to the requirement that the portion of the total amount paid which corresponds to the unused services and accommodations be refunded. Passengers requiring special assistance, including without limitation those who permanently or periodically use a wheelchair, must be accompanied by someone who is fit and able to assist them, and who will be totally responsible for providing all required assistance.

AIR TRANSPORTATION-The price of this trip is based on an Advance Purchase Excursion fare. After tickets are issued, penalties up to 100% of the ticket price may be levied. If connecting flights are requested, special promotional fares may be used, in which case penalties of as much as 100% may be assessed by the airlines if reservations are changed or cancelled after ticketing. After departure, if the reservations are changed, you will be charged the higher, all year Economy class fare. VARIATIONS TO THE GROUP ITINERARY MUST BE REQUESTED NO LATER THAN 60 DAYS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.

CANCELLATION-In addition to airline cancellation penalties, all cancellations for any reason whatsoever will be subject to a \$150 per person cancellation fee. Cancellation from 90-61 days prior to departure will result in forfeiture of 10% of the entire cost of the trip per person; 60-31 days, 30%; 30-15 days, 50%. Cancellation from 14 days up to the time of departure will result in forfeiture of the entire cost of the trip. TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE IS AVAILABLE. AN APPLICATION WILL BE SENT AFTER YOU RESERVE. All cancellations must be submitted in writing to AHI International Corporation.

BAGGAGE-The most restrictive airline regulations permit two checked pieces per passenger for which the sum total of the linear dimensions for each checked piece must not exceed 62 inches (height+length+width) and each bag should not weigh more than 50 pounds. One piece of carry-on baggage is allowed per passenger, for which the linear dimensions for the carry-on bag must not exceed 22 inches x 16 inches x 8 inches, must not weigh more than 18 pounds and must fit completely underneath an aircraft seat. Differing baggage allowances may apply, depending on program carrier. Baggage allowances are subject to change by the carrier without notice. Excess baggage charges for additional or oversized/overweight pieces are expensive and not included in your trip price; plan your wardrobe accordingly.
